

# No to 350 houses & school on Harts Farm

## Objecting to the Hertsmere Draft Local Plan



Hertsmere want to build nearly 3,000 houses in Bushey's Green Belt, including 350 on Harts Farm. (With another 750 further down Little Bushey Lane.)

### Reasons to object

- Housing demand has fallen according to Government figures
- Government says brownfield sites to be used before Green Belt
- 1200 extra cars on Little Bushey Lane. (More with the other development.) Our survey shows a 12% increase in last three years.
- The site is a flood plain and Little Bushey Lane already floods without 350 more houses.

- Loss of wildlife including protected muntjac deer, pipistrelle bats and Canada geese
- Nearest bus route with limited evening and Sunday services is 10 minute walk away

### How to object

Act **NOW** before Harts Farm is lost forever. It is described as site B1, land east of Little Bushey Lane in the Hertsmere Draft Local Plan.
