

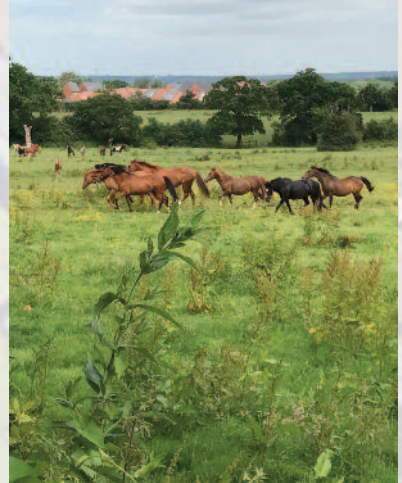
Help stop the release of our green belt land for development

These fields will disappear forever if we don't act now

In the Hertsmere Draft Local Plan, Green Belt land grazed for centuries at Harts Farm and the adjoining fields will disappear under 350 houses and a primary school.

Unless we challenge these proposals **NOW** they will proceed with plans to develop Little Bushey Lane beyond recognition.

Imagine an extra 1,200 cars on the Lane; increased likelihood of flooding; competition for places at stretched secondary schools; even longer waiting times for doctors; loss of our dwindling wildlife habitats; and of course, no public transport. This precious Green Belt needs to be protected for future generations.
